Prairie Tides chronicles the Illinois and Michigan Canal and the "tides" of change across the Illinois prairies—from Native Americans, to French explorers, to fur traders, to farmers and settlers, to those who built Chicago into a world-class city. It illuminates the story of the I&M canal as a catalyst for Illinois's transformation from a frontier state to a seat of commerce and industry. Personal stories of the visionaries who planned the canal and the immigrants who built it are brought to life through historical photographs, artifacts, graphics and impressionistic action sequences.
